## Who can participate?

African American/Black women who:

- Have been diagnosed with breast cancer
- Are age 20 or older
- Live in Alabama or Mississippi

*We are looking for African American breast cancer survivors to participate in a research study that will help us to develop a breast cancer education program.*



## WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- Participants in this study will complete a brief survey and participate in an interview via Zoom that will last about 60 minutes. During the interview, participants will be asked to share information about their experience being diagnosed with breast cancer and their experiences during cancer treatment. Participants will also be asked to share messages to motivate women to get a breast cancer screening.
- The interview will be recorded, and some parts of the recording will be included in an educational video about breast cancer.
- Compensation will be provided for research participation.
